Clara M. and Peter L. Scott Faculty Award for Excellence in Engineering Education

The Clara M. and Peter L. Scott Faculty Award for Outstanding Academic Achievement was established by Clara M. and Peter L. Scott (B.S. Electrical Engineering '49 DRH '95) and consists of \$3000 gross and a plaque. It will be presented at the Faculty Awards Banquet in May 2009.

CRITERIA

The award will be made to a senior professor in engineering or architecture in the College of Engineering who has distinguished himself or herself nationally or internationally. The award will be based on excellence in teaching and the qualitative aspects of teaching with emphasis on effective innovation, and for outstanding fundamental or applied research contributions (in scope and/or originality) in one or more areas of endeavor. The award will normally be made to an individual and may be made only once in a faculty member's career. Under unique circumstance, a team may be nominated for and receive the award.

NOMINATIONS

One nomination may be submitted by each Department in the College. The nomination packet will include a letter of nomination, one to three letters of support and supporting materials. Be brief and to the point, yet include sufficient information to permit a rational selection. At least one letter from an external source (and no more than three), solicited without input from the nominee, is required. The total number of supporting letters (including the external letter) should not exceed three. Please submit a curriculum vitae of the nominee. Nominations must include a citation of no more than 50 words, highlighting the reasons for the nomination. This citation will be used in the program if the nominee is selected for this award.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee will consist of the Dean of the College of Engineering, one or more representatives from the College of Engineering faculty, one or more representatives external to the University, and one graduate and one undergraduate member of the Engineering student body.

DEADLINE

The application materials will all be submitted electronically. The total nomination package must be submitted by February 27, 2009.
